RE: Oklahoma State Government Asset Reduction and Cost Savings

Program (74 O.S. §61.7)

Effective November 1, 2011, House Bill 1438 established the Oklahoma State Government Asset Reduction and Cost Savings Program. The new law, 74 O.S. §61.7 mandates the Director of the Department of Central Services to publish a comprehensive report detailing state-owned properties no later than December 31<sup>st</sup> each year, which includes a list of the five percent most underutilized properties. The Director is also charged with promulgating rules establishing procedures to collect necessary data from each state agency, board, commission and public trust having the State as a beneficiary to develop the report.

This memo is to make you aware of the new law and to request your agency to report its real property inventory using the attached State Real Property Inventory Report. This report may duplicate information submitted to DCS in the past; however, taking an inventory of inventories represents our first step towards developing the new Program. Your cooperation ensures the integrity of the information that will establish the foundation of the Program.

We will communicate updates about the Program as they develop. Our first goal is to build a dynamic real property inventory that is continuously updated and monitored in order to provide an integral tool for state planning and operations.
