- Better data for capital planning






## Benefits to the institution

- Compliance with SB1096
- Infrastructure and resources to manage your building systems and utility expenses
- 80% of your savings stays with institution
- Ability to more accurately benchmark against peers
- · Opportunities for recognition
- Data to make your case:
  - How well you are managing your resources
  - What facilities should be prioritized for investmen





# Steps to Get Started

#1 Issue purchase order (\$1.00 or \$0.01) #2 Complete Infrastructure Survey & Spreadsheet

- Receive energy manager recommendation
- Compile utility data:
  - Set up EnergyCAP and enter data by Oct.

1

- Send data to ES2 in the meantime
- Identify energy manager
- Engage stakeholders and plan program
