**Subject:** Governor Fallin's Executive Order 2015-06 – Personnel Freeze

Last Friday, February 6, Governor Fallin issued Executive Order 2015-06 (copy attached). This Executive Order establishes a State agency personnel action freeze (personnel freeze).

Executive Order 2015-06 is similar in all relevant respects to the Executive Order which first established a personnel freeze (referred to in that Executive Order as a "hiring freeze"). That order was issued in 1995, and was the subject of an official Attorney General Opinion issued in 1996. In that opinion, the Attorney General stated that the hiring freeze provision of the statute upon which the 1995 Executive Order was based did not apply to constitutionally-created boards of regents but did apply to institutions governed by statutorily-created boards of regents or trustees. That Attorney General Opinion is equally applicable to the current Executive Order 2015-06, as it also is based upon the same provision in the same statute.

In addition, recent legislation which consolidated the IT services for all state agencies under the Office of Management and Enterprise Services <u>explicitly exempted all institutions of the State System of Higher Education from that consolidation.</u> For that reason, paragraph 3 concerning IT services of Executive Order 2015-06 is not applicable to any of the institutions in the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education.
