8 An Act relating to state property; requiring state
9 agencies under certain conditions to provide fencing
10 of property; defining term; exempting certain state
11 properties; providing for codification; and providing
12 an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 327.4 of Title 61, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. For state property held by the state pursuant to Section 327
18 of Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes, state agencies that have
19 jurisdiction over parcels of land leased for livestock use
20 containing eighty (80) or more acres of contiguous land shall
21 provide permanent fencing for the perimeter of the property. The
22 agency shall provide the fencing and not the lessee.

23 For the purposes of this section, "permanent fencing" shall mean
24 four wires with the three top wires being barbed with the bottom

1 wire not barbed. Any fence that is over one-quarter (1/4) of a mile
2 in length shall have a wooden post every fifth post.

3 B. State-owned property pursuant to Section 2200 et seq. of
4 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes and Section 861 et seq. of Title
5 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be exempt from provisions of this
6 section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
