3. Applicant must have a minimum ACT of 18
4. Applicant must plan to attend an accredited education institution as a full-time student

The following documentation must be returned with the application

1. A completed application
2. Official Academic Transcript with ACT score posted
3. Three letters of recommendation from unrelated persons who know you well
EX. Principal, Teacher, Advisor, Pastor, Employer, or Community Leader
4. Narrative outlining your goals and how you plan to attain them. Need is not the primary factor in awarding this scholarship, however if you have+
5. special needs please cover them in the narrative.
