Rules and Regulations for Covington-Douglas Concurrent Enrollment Scholarship Program

Participants must be CD students in good standing with the school.

Classes must be provided by NOC.

The yearly monetary maximum will be determined by the CD Board of Education each August.

Qualifying coursework will have the tuition paid by the state of Oklahoma.

CD Schools will pay up to \$100/qualifying credit hour to assist in the payment of fees as long as funds exist in the donation account of the activity fund that have been earmarked for scholarships.

No student shall receive more than \$600/semester.

Students must take all courses on the CD campus or the NOC campus.

Priority for the funds will be determined by:

- Seniority: seniors first then juniors
- Student GPA while attending CD Schools

Students must be enrolled in fall classes by Memorial day prior to the fall semester and by Thanksgiving for the spring semester.

Students will need to make at least an A or a B in concurrent coursework to be eligible for the following semester.

These rules may be adjusted on an as-needed basis by the CD Board of Education and should in no way be considered guaranteed funds.
