	Are you deemed homeless or at risk of being homeless?
Items	needed:
	Social security number
	Driver's license number
	Alien Registration Number if you are not a U.S. citizen
	2015 federal tax returns including IRS W-2 information for you and your spouse if you are married:  o IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ and W-2s
	Records of untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans non-education benefits for you and your spouse
	Child support paid by you and/or spouse
	Information on the following: cash, savings and checking account balances, investments, such as stocks and bonds and real estate but not including the home in which you live, and business and farm assets for you and your spouse  Do not include a family farm or family business with 100 or fewer full-time or full-time equivalent employees.
