Activity rating awarded for % of division/department/office members who donate a minimum of 3 non-perishable food items to the Library's annual food drive.  
*Sign-in sheet available in the Library, please deliver donations there to confirm your participation.*

**3. Monday, Nov. 4 – Chili Cook-Off**

100% activity rating per division/department/office that enters chili in the contest.  
*Pre-registration required (form available at [eosc.edu](http://eosc.edu)). Judging begins at 6 p.m.*

**4. Wednesday, Nov. 6 – Door Decoration**

100% activity rating per division/department/office that decorates an office door in the 2019 Homecoming theme "Move Mountains"  
*Areas participating will be inspected. Must be completed by 4 p.m.*

**5. Thursday, Nov. 7 – Spirit Signs in Gym**

100% activity rating per division/department/office that creates a spirit poster to cheer on the basketball teams.  
*Preferred size is 24"x36" (like the poster board you find at the dollar store).  
Your department/office name must be included to receive credit. Posters must be hung by 4 p.m.*

**6. Saturday, Nov. 9 – Mountaineer 5K OR 1-Mile Fun Run**

Activity rating awarded for % of division/department/office members who participate in or volunteer at the Mountaineer 5K/1-Mile Fun Run.  
*Pre-registration required for participation (form available at [eosc.edu](http://eosc.edu)). Sign-in sheet available for volunteers.*

**WINNER:** The division/department/office with the highest activity rating for the week will win the Spirit Stick. In case of a tie, there will be a tie-breaker activity during the Mountaineer Tailgate on Saturday.

**NOTE:** A division/department/office will be defined by the Wilburton-based faculty/staff members within that area as shown in the phone/email directory. This will ensure that teams are not penalized in participation percentages for faculty/staff who have their primary teaching responsibilities or office on another campus. However, you may designate a substitute in your department from another campus if they want to participate.
