

## High School Concurrent Program

#### **ADMISSIONS CRITERIA**

Concurrent high school students must be eligible to satisfy the high school curricular requirements for college no later than the spring of their senior year. A high school student may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester, not to exceed a seven (7) class period schedule. For purposes of calculating workload, one-half high school credit course shall be equivalent to three semester credit hours of college work. A high school student must meet <u>ONE</u> of the following requirements for admission:

- · an unweighted 3.0 GPA
- a 19 composite ACT score (National or Residual ACT, including "superscore" as calculated by ACT, and pre-ACT acceptable)
- · a 990 total SAT or PSAT score

#### **COURSE PLACEMENT**

#### Option #1 Automatic Placement

To register in a credit-bearing course, the student must have

- a 19 ACT / pre-ACT sub-score or a 501 SAT / PSAT sub-score or a passing Accuplacer score in the area of enrollment AND
- meet the Admission Criteria

#### Option #2: Specific Subject Placement

To register for a course that is NOT Mathematics or English or Science (such as History, Psychology, Speech, Humanities, etc.), the student must

· Have an unweighted GPA of 3.0

To register for a credit bearing **Mathematics** course, the student must:

- · have an unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or higher, AND
- have completed three Math classes, one of which being Algebra II, with grades of B or better

To register for an English Comp I course, the student must:

- · have an unweighted high school GPA of 3.0, AND
- · have completed three years of English, with grades of B or better

To register for a Science course, the student must:

- · satisfy both Mathematics and English Subject Placements AND
- · meet any potential prerequisites.
