

2024 Chili Cook-Off Competition Information!

CHILI: Defined by the Homecoming Committee as any kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with various spices and other ingredients including beans. Garnishes are allowed.

LOGISTICS: Each team will need to have at least a 6 QT crock-pot of chili. Each team will be given one (1) bowl for Judging. The Bowl will be filled with the contestant's CHILI and supplied to the Floor Monitor to be taken to the judges for tasting. Please bring a copy of your recipe to the contest. Following the judging, the team should be prepared for public tasting.

SPACE: Each team will be provided a 6-foot table and 2 chairs. Please bring your own extension cord and table coverings/decorations. Taster bowls, utensils, etc. will be provided.

ENTRY FEE: None! This event is open to EOSC faculty, staff, and students, as well as community businesses, organizations, and individuals.

DEADLINE: Entry form must be received by noon on Nov. 1 to ensure a space in the competition.

CHECK-IN: Check-in will begin at 5 p.m. All booths are to be set up and ready to operate by 5:45 p.m. for judging. Open to the public at 6:30.

AWARDS: The top entry in each division will be recognized, as well as a Taster's Choice Award.
