

# Ethical Hacking Webinar Series

This twice-weekly webinar series will focus on teaching information security and assurance professionals about commonly used free and open source hacking technologies. In each session, Clay Risenhoover, CISSP, CISA, CISM, CEH, will instruct participants on the basics of the tools and techniques, and give examples of how they may be employed to find weak security controls within organizations. The course is **intermediate** in level, and is intended for students who have an understanding of Internet technologies and commonly deployed security controls.

- Intelligence gathering
- The nmap port scanner
- Advanced nmap and other scanners
- The Metasploit framework
- Database and operating system security attacks
- Web application attacks
- Password attacks
- Methods for maintaining system access
- Vulnerability scanners
