## EARLY ENROLLMENT SCHEDULE

### **Online Priority Registration October 26 - 30, 2009**

Online Priority Registration: Period when Junior, Senior and Graduate level students can register themselves online. Must have accumulated 61 hrs or more. Associate degree students MUST register through advisor.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES**:

- Meet with your advisor to find out what courses you still need in order to meet your degree requirements.
- Students can register at home, work, campus Library, etc.
- REGISTER NOW to ensure you get the classes you prefer

## Priority Registration November 2 - 6, 2009

- Priority Registration is the period when students classified as freshmen, sophomore, undecided and non-degree register through their advisors.
  - Make an appointment with your advisor to plan schedule and register.

## **Registration Restrictions:**

- MUST complete all Admissions requirements before YOU can register!
- MUST not have any Institutional HOLDS that will prevent you from registering!
- Students on Academic Probation CANNOT pre-register until final grades are in.

**NOTE**: The De-Enrollment date for Spring 2010 Pre-Enrolled students, due to non-payment of Fall 2009 balance, is December 7, 2010.
