



CURBSIDE PICKUP

Based on some initial research, it appears that designating some 5-15 minute parking zones for curbside pickup purposes throughout the Main Street district would provide uniformity and clarity versus each business trying to designate their own pickup zones business-by-business.

The process of Curbside Pickup in downtown areas may differ slightly from that in suburban areas and chain restaurants, where the expectation is that the order is brought directly to your vehicle. These Curbside Pickup Zones would be more for being able to find a convenient parking spot easily and quickly, allowing you to walk up to the business to retrieve your order. Whichever final order delivery method is used, it will need to be clearly communicated to patrons whether they are to be waiting in their vehicles (which would require the spots to be numbered for identification), or whether they need to do a walk-up style pickup. This may vary based on community preference and the size of the Main Street area.
