New Reinvestment Reporting



Each designated community is required by Main Street America (MSA) & the Oklahoma Main Street Center (OMSC) to achieve **125 points per year** to meet the annual contract agreement.

Forty-five of these points must come from reporting on time each month.

Submitting a NEW Reinvestment Report


Complete questions about your program.

When filling out, read the question asked; if the answer is "NO," leave as is.

If "YES", select additional field questions will populate as in example "2".

Complete each applicable question.

If "Yes" is selected, you must enter a # and \$ amount, either "Private" or "Public," or the report will be incomplete.




When you get to the bottom of the form, you will see "Volunteer Hours and Additional Remarks".

Remember: Monthly board and committee meetings count.

Remarks: Leave key notes, should you need to reference your numbers again.

Remarks Example: Joe's Pharmacy, façade Rehab. 10,000.

Volunteer hours – 300 for shopping on main event








Forty-five of these points must come from reporting on time each month.



You can upload flyers, agenda, or confirmation emails to support your request.













Four Points Approach




As you look through each of the FOUR POINTS, you can find material related to each of the points.




When you select any of the FOUR POINTS titles, they will open to a list of resources. To the right, you can also look at a drop-down of the resource titles in the selected folder.


You can sort by Description, Title, and URL.





Main Street Document Area




Each of these folders will list resources just as the FOUR POINTS section does, but for the **Board Members**, **Directors**, and **Program-Related information**. Take time to explore.

Reinvestment Infographics


Reinvestment Infographics are created in February for **DESIGNATED** Main Street programs for the following year.

However, if numbers were entered for the year, you can reach out to your liaison to request an infographic of your reported numbers.


Below, you can sort by Title, Description, and Program.
