First Friday - Vendor Info - 2017

First Fridays provide a fun after-hours shopping, dining and entertaining experience Downtown Enid, April through November.

Vendors include any individual, group, business or organization wanting to set up a table, booth or area to give items, share information or sell products. Vendors **MUST** follow these rules.

Food Trucks have other requirements. Please contact us for food truck vendor information.

- Vendors are **ONLY allowed on the Courthouse Lawn**, *NOT on sidewalks in front of businesses. Businesses may NOT give permission to set up on sidewalks during First Fridays.*
- There is currently **NO** Vendor fee to Main Street Enid. This may change without notice.
- Vendors are responsible for supplying their own tables, chairs, lights, etc.
- There are not designated areas on the Courthouse Lawn and space will not be saved.
- Vendors must be completely set up and ready **by 6:00 pm** and must stay set up until **9:00 pm**. *Because when vendors pack up early, attendees see that and assume the entire event is ending early.*
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and paying **Sales Tax**.
- **Commercial food vendors** are solely responsible for meeting the requirements of the **Garfield County Health Department**. For info, call 580-233-0650, x126 or x127.
- All licenses, permits and insurance are the responsibility of the Vendor.
- Main Street Enid will **not be responsible** for theft, accident, or damage occurring at any event.
- **Inflatables, rides and similar activities** are **ONLY** allowed if Vendor provides general liability policy with \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, \$2,000,000.00 general aggregate limits, naming Main Street Enid, Inc., Garfield County and the City of Enid as additional insureds.
- **NOT allowed:** petitions, political booths, pushy sales, yelling, and unfriendliness.
- Main Street Enid, the City of Enid, and Garfield County reserve the right to not allow Vendors for any reason.

2017 Dates - Availability may change without notice.

- April 7 - Cars must be moved **OUTSIDE** of blocked area for the Glow Run
- May 5 - Cars must be moved **OUTSIDE** of blocked area for the Tri-State Parade
- June 2 - **NO VENDORS** - Courthouse Lawn is **RESERVED** for Relay for Life
- July 7
- August 4 - **NO VENDORS** - Courthouse Lawn is **RESERVED**
- September 8 - **NO VENDORS** - Courthouse Lawn is **RESERVED**
- October 6
- November 3
