Dear Mr. Frantz:

It was a pleasure meeting you at the Rehabitat convention in Kansas City and talking to you about the Oklahoma installations Union Metal supplied prior to 1930.

Attached for your use is a listing of the Oklahoma cities where Union Metal furnished poles for the period of 1906 - 1930. Our records are only complete to July 1, 1930 so we cannot tell what we supplied after this date. Also attached are three copies of our Nostalgia Lighting Series brochure.

For ease of identification I have noted on the listing those designs shown in the brochure. However, this brochure does not show all of our capabilities. We have literally thousands of original patterns available and can make many, many more designs than those shown in the brochure. Because design 856 seemed to be a popular design used in several cities, I have attached a copy of the catalog page from our 1924 catalog. The patterns are available for this design so we could also make this today using the original patterns.

From the listing, you can see the most popular designs were #874, 1571, 807 and 856. Design 874 is shown in our brochure in the National Family and designs 1571 and 807 shown in the Columbian Family. Therefore, from the brochure and the #856 catalog page you can identify the majority of the poles supplied in Oklahoma by Union Metal from 1906 - 1930.

However, upon reviewing the listing, if you wish to identify a particular design not shown in the brochure, we would be happy to research our 1924 catalog and/or old drawings to identify and also check the pattern availability and condition.
