**Whereas**, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education has created multiple pathways for adults to re-connect with a college or university to earn an associate's degree or a bachelor's degree, such as the Reach Higher FlexFinish program and the Reach Higher DirectComplete programs; and

**Whereas**, Oklahoma higher education partners with tribal education departments, state agencies, and nonprofit organizations to identify resources for adults returning to college; and

**Whereas**, Oklahoma adults returning to earn degrees will improve their own lives and those of their families in terms of economic opportunities, as well as personal achievements; and

**Whereas**, Oklahoma's prosperity as a state is dependent on an educated and credentialed workforce;
