Dear Presidents:

Re: Approval of Revisions to the *In-state/Out-of-State Status of Enrolled Students* policy

At their June 24, 2022 meeting, the State Regents approved revisions to the *In-state/Out-of-State Status of Enrolled Students* policy.

Prompted by changes made in the 2022 legislative session to 70 O.S. 2021, Section 3247, which governs which members of the uniformed services are entitled to in-state status, the policy revisions include:

- Add members of the uniformed services who were stationed in Oklahoma for at least one year in the previous ten years, along with the member's spouse and/or dependents, to the list of enrolled students entitled to in-state status (House Bill 1800);
- Increase the length of time that members of the uniformed services who are discharged or released from active service after a period of at least 90 days are entitled to in-state status from five to ten years, including their spouses and dependents (House Bill 1800); and
- Add current members of the Oklahoma National Guard to the list of enrolled students entitled to in-state status (Senate Bill 1416).
