Re: Chancellor Hans Brisch Scholarship

I invite you to nominate one of your graduating seniors for consideration as a 2023 Chancellor Hans Brisch Scholar. The Chancellor's Scholars program was established in 1990 by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education with privately raised funds and has recognized 97 students to date. On March 23, 2006, the State Regents renamed the program the Chancellor Hans Brisch Scholarship Program in memory of Chancellor Emeritus Hans Brisch.

The nominated student must have demonstrated a commitment to the enhancement of his/her community or school. Evidence of this commitment might be found in the initiation of a program or project in the school or community that resulted in an improvement of the learning environment or the social betterment of the community. The nominee should demonstrate high academic achievement and have a proven record of leadership success. Also, the nominee must plan to attend an Oklahoma public college or university beginning Fall 2023 to qualify for the award.

Recipients of the prestigious Chancellor Hans Brisch Scholarship will be presented a one-time award of \$2,000 from the State Regents at one of their Spring 2023 meetings and will also be recognized in statewide and local media releases. Winners will be notified prior to the announcement and will be posted on our website at www.okhighered.org.

PLEASE RETAIN THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR RECORDS.

GENERAL:

- Type or clearly print on all forms.
- **Nominations must be made by the principal.** Only nominations with the principal's signature will be accepted.
- **Qualified students must plan to attend an Oklahoma public college or university.** Nominees planning to attend an in-state private or any out-of-state college or university cannot be considered. Please refer to the list on page 2 to confirm that your nominee is eligible for the award.
- **Do not distribute this nomination form. Each school may nominate only one student.** Schools submitting more than one nomination risk disqualifying all nominees from that school.
- All personal information, including the nominee's name, city, and school, will be omitted prior to review by the selection panel.
- Special portfolios (binders, notebooks, etc.) will be deconstructed, with the included materials submitted to the selection panel in a manner consistent to all nominees.
- Do not submit any unique original materials. Items submitted with your nomination will not be returned.
- Test scores and transcripts are accepted but not required. All supporting documentation should be submitted at the principal's discretion.
- If submitting by mail, your nomination should be postmarked by **Friday, December 2, 2022.**
- If submitting electronically, please send to awinge@osrhe.edu by **Friday, December 2, 2022.**

- Recipients of the Chancellor Hans Brisch Scholarship are chosen largely based on their involvement in the betterment of their schools and communities. Community service will account for **two-thirds** of the nominee's overall score.

PART C – OUTSTANDING LEADERSHIP:

- Leadership characteristics will account for one-sixth of the nominee's overall score.
- On a separate sheet or sheets, describe the outstanding leadership characteristics of the nominee and provide examples of demonstrated leadership.

PART D – HIGH ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT:

- Academic achievement will account for one-sixth of the nominee's overall score.
- On a separate sheet or sheets, describe the nominee's high academic achievement, including GPA and academic honors.
