

# ITEMS NEEDED TO COMPLETE A FAFSA

**Important:** Be sure to create an account and set up a username and password (FSA ID) at [StudentAid.gov](https://StudentAid.gov) at least five days before completing your FAFSA. Create your ID at [StudentAid.gov](https://StudentAid.gov), or go to [StudentAid.gov/Create Account](https://StudentAid.gov/Create Account) to begin. Parents with Social Security numbers will also need to create their own FSA IDs.

Before you begin the FAFSA, be sure to gather the following information:

- Your FSA ID (see above)
- Your Social Security number
- Your alien registration number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your parent(s)' date of birth, current address, Social Security number and email address
- Your **2022** federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
- The current total of your cash, savings and checking accounts
- Records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- Net worth of farm(s) or business(es) (if applicable)
