Purpose: The Minority Science and Engineering Improvement Program (MSEIP) is designed to effect long-range improvement in science and engineering education at predominately minority institutions and to increase the flow of underrepresented ethnic minorities, particularly minority women, into scientific and technological careers.

Examples of what MSEIP supports: student research projects in STEM fields; stipends for eligible college student receiving special tutoring or skills needed to be successful in STEM courses, particularly gate-keeper courses; enhanced curriculum development in STEM fields; renovation of STEM labs/classrooms; pre-college STEM programs for eligible K-12 students/teachers; faculty STEM research projects at federal laboratories. (Eligibility requirements must be met.)
